Introduction

In the introduction paragraph, student gives appropriate background information and **effective thesis statement** with two clear causes by using advanced grammatical structures such as **present perfect** and **its time markers** and a **variety of adjectives and adverbs** as well as advanced vocabulary such as 'leap into', 'exponential', 'with the advancements', 'lead to' and 'increase in'.

1st body paragraph

In the first body paragraph, student gives two supporting ideas and their details with examples related to the first cause 'accessibility'. Having more airports and provision of public transportation are given as the supporting ideas for accessibility. Use of advanced grammar structures like 'once', 'as', 'so that' and the **reduced relative clause** 'located in large cities' and the other one referring to the whole sentence ', causing a dramatic increase in preference' have led to a strong body paragraph.

2nd body paragraph

In the second body paragraph, student gives a detailed explanation of the second cause 'time'. Use of complex sentences like 'Consequently, one of the main **reasons** for the significant **increase in** domestic flights **is that** it offers people **what** 21st century steals from them; time' and advanced vocabulary have led to a strong body paragraph. There are some minor mistakes like lack of comma before so and spelling mistake like 'traveled', which accounts for missing one point.

Conclusion paragraph

This paragraph has a strong summary and final comment. Two causes in the thesis statement are restated clearly. Correct use of **double comparatives** 'the smaller the world gets, the more ...' and **the conjunctions** 'since', 'although' has contributed a lot to this strong conclusion paragraph.
